Five different Writing Groups were represented -the u3a Zoom Group Pen and Pen, Words Inc previously a Northern Libraries writing Group, Sanderlings, a Portstewart Group, This Writing Thing, a group of writers from Derry/Londonderry and Donegal, and finally Portglenone Writers.

These turned out in force to honour the man who had made sure their work was published, some for the first time.

Others in the hall however attended to hear the excellent selection of poetry and stories performed by 14 different writer/performers, each one representing a different Initiative begun by Steve.

A broad cross-section of work was very much enjoyed by the crowd.

Steve's wife Nikki, as well as his son Charlie, now the new Editor of Impspired, flew over from Lincoln for the event.

Charlie thanked everyone for their continued support as he works to honour his father's legacy, re-shaping Impspired by designing a new business model which builds upon his father's visionary work. Just as his father did, he plans to continue publishing

both the bi-monthly Impspired online magazine, as well as individual Collections and Anthologies.
